HIROSHIMA ATTACKED BY A MYSTERIOUS BOMB

In the early morning of August 6, 1945 communications with Hiroshima were cut. Nearby residents noticed a cloud of smoke in the sky, and heard a huge explosion. Witnesses say they saw an airplane in the sky moments before the event. Around 70,000 people were killed instantly by the blast of a mysterious bomb. We do not have many details on said bomb yet, but we do know it is no normal one. Its blast reached about 6,400 feet from the ground zero. There are fires throughout the city, and the temperatures are extremely high.

President Harry S. Truman notified the American public on the morning of August 6th about the bombing. He mentioned that the US is in possession of a powerful new bomb that could be the one to end the war. Hopefully, we will have more details about the bomb and its origins soon.

People have been dying in the past few days of injuries from burns, fallen debris and other effects from the blast. Yuki Hamasaki, a survivor, said that she heard a deafening sound before everything turned white. Doctors are attending her because she is suffering from severe burns. One of the mysterious symptoms of victims is radiation sickness. This is a new illness, never heard of when bombs are involved. A victim, going by the name of Kitamura, was the first person to be discovered with radiation sickness. We tried to get in contact, but Kitamura refused to comment. He has been hurt deeply psychologically by the events. This is something that's been happening to many survivors. Seeing family members die near them have made them unable to talk. The psychological effect of the blast is amazing and heartbreaking. Surviving has been considered a curse by some of the citizens.
